Greetings from Sakila. The staff and students are doing well and always pray for you.

This is our harvest time, and the prices for staple crops are getting much better. We have 110 Bible students who get three meals a day plus hungry people from the village who stop by anytime for a hot meal. The staff get hot meals when they are on campus as well as extra dry corn and beans when their food supplies run low. There are other places where we distribute food, like Crower Trade School, the farm, and villages where there are starving people. Also, from time to time villagers stop for extra dry food because they have none.

We are surrounded by people with needs. I never sell food for extra finances, and I will not sell food as the need is too great!

We are thankful to the Lord for people like you who care and respond to the needs, whether it is through prayer, finances to support the ministry, or your sacrifices of time and money to come visit us in Tanzania.

We have been visiting churches around Tanzania, and the churches are growing like mushrooms. It is revival time here in our country!
