Tribute to Pastor Jim Bedsole



Pastor Jim Bedsole of San Diego, CA passed away on Sept. 19, 2023. We mourn with his many friends, family members, and church members, and yet we do not grieve as those who have no hope (1 Thessalonians 4:13).

We rejoice that he has met our Lord and Savior face to face and heard Him say, "Well done, good and faithful servant."

Jim's legacy includes 48 years of marriage, three children and 11 grandchildren, and 47 years of ministry in 17 nations. We are grateful for his 40 years of partnership and dedicated service to the people of Tanzania. He was serving as IEO Board President at the time of his passing.

In his final days, Jim encouraged his wife, Shirley, to make the trip they had planned to Tanzania in October. She did so, teaching at the Bible school, exhorting and edifying the Bible school students and Hebron graduates, blessing the Christ Hope Orphanage children and Crower Trade school students, and visiting many longtime friends and ministry partners.
