I appreciate your prayers for the ministry and for my travels in America. It was a blessing to finish our second session of the Bible school this year with 73 students graduating just before I left Tanzania.

So many things have been accomplished this year. We welcomed visitors from Oregon, Montana, Wyoming, and Tennessee. Many villages were visited by doctors and nurses, nearly 400 people received reading glasses, and three large playgrounds were built. Here are some other highlights and updates from 2024:

- The radio is doing well with your prayers. Millions of people from three states tune in to New Life Radio.
- At the trade school, many young people have learned trades like masonry, carpentry, sewing, and welding.
- We thank God for water projects made possible by the Family Life church in Wyoming. This year we drilled one well in Valleska Village. God is good.
- At the orphanage, many kids have progressed in their education to university and have finished their degrees through your support. We are so thankful and happy to continue helping more children.
- At Hebron High School, all of the Form 6 students passed their exams this year and will go to on to university.
- The growth of the churches is wonderful as this year we have planted churches in Malawi, Zambia, and Tanzania.

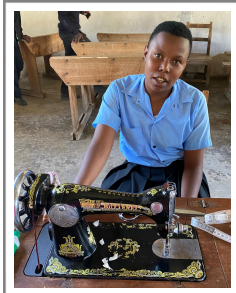
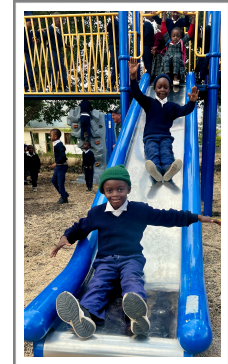
Several mission teams traveled to Tanzania this year to complete various projects and minister to people through prayer, practical service, and generous giving with the help of many churches and friends in the U.S.

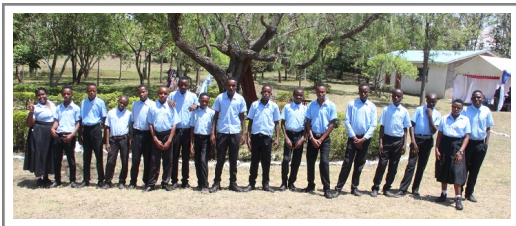
